English

This week in English we will be reading and writing different types of poetry.

Task 1- Using the BBC bitesize [link](#), have a look at how to write an acrostic poem. Have a look at the following [website](#) and try to write your own acrostic poem. This could be based on a few things such as: your name, your favourite hobby or your favourite season.

Task 2 – Today you are going to be looking at how to perform a poem. Use the oak national academy [website](#) to research the key skills for performing poems. Choose a poem from this [website](#). Have a go at learning the poem, adding expression and actions and then performing it to someone at home.

Task 3- Your final task for the week will test the addition skills you have learnt this week. Use the oak national academy [link](#) to help practise addition with more than one regrouping.
